Every power as Thou shalt choose.



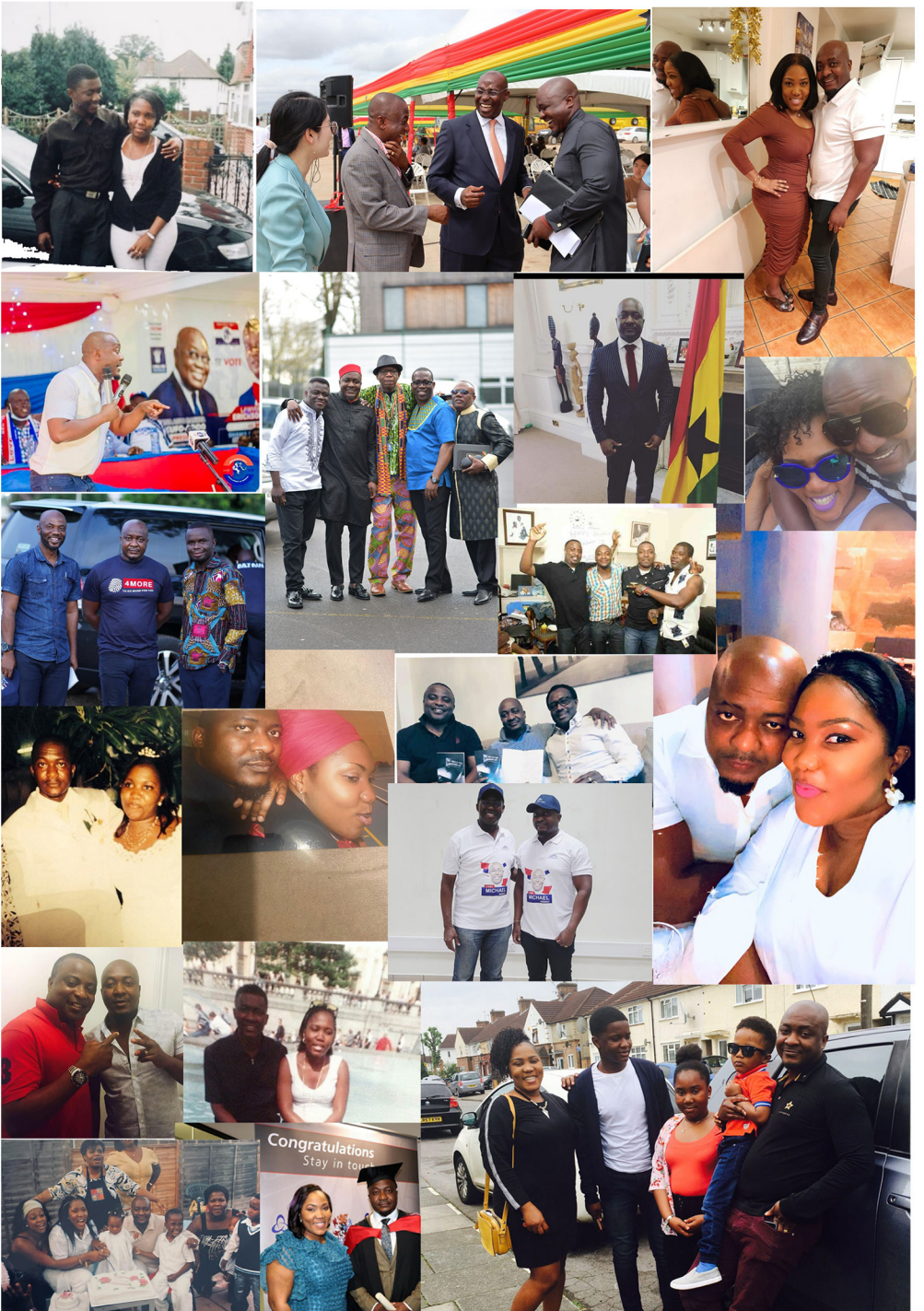

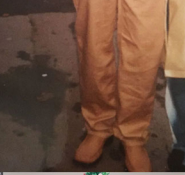
